The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

The Tribunal finds that the appellant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment based on the following information.

Date of Birth: 26 February 1980
Date of commencement of employment: 26 October 2001
Date of termination of employment: 21 December 2007

Gross weekly pay: €693.50

The period from the 26 October 2007 until the 9 December 2007, during which the appellant was absent is to be treated as non-reckonable service for the purpose of computing the lump sum payment.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social

Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
The Tribunal also awards him the sum of €1870.50 being the equivalent of three weeks pay (exclusive of his monthly bonus) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973to 2005.
