Determination:

Having heard all the evidence from both parties the Tribunal determines that a redundancy situation existed and that there was a transfer of the business to the respondent the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003, succeeds. Accordingly, the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment according to the following criteria:

Employment commenced: 26th October 2004
Employment ceased: 02nd August 2008
Gross pay: €374.00

Please note that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600 applies to all payments from the Social Insurance Fund. This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
