Determination:

There was no appearance by either party. The Tribunal made a telephone call to the number of the appellant as furnished by him on the Form T1A but there was no answer. The Tribunal also contacted the respondent by telephone, however the respondent had no current contact information for the appellant. The Tribunal notes a letter on the file from the appellant requesting a hearing prior to 28th March 2009 on the grounds that the appellant was returning to Poland on that date. However the appellant did not furnish any alternative contact arrangements in the event of the matter being listed for hearing after that date. Lacking any means of contacting the appellant the Tribunal declines to adjourn the matter and the Tribunal finds that the matter fails for want of prosecution.
