The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the claimant was properly notified of this hearing.

She neither appeared for this hearing nor contacted the Tribunal in connection with that non-appearance. Her legal team were present but had no instructions from their client. Their efforts to contact the claimant also proved fruitless.

Having heard submissions from both sides the Tribunal dismisses the claim under the Unfair Dismissal Acts, 1977 to 2007, and the appeals under the Minimum Notice and the Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 and the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997 for want of prosecution.

Since there was no clear evidence that the claimant's application to the Tribunal was frivolous or vexatious the Tribunal does not accede to the respondent's application for costs.
