The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal is satisfied that a transfer of undertakings took place and the Tribunal is furthermore satisfied that the appellant had the requisite service to bring a claim under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007.

The Tribunal awards the appellant a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on his continuous service and the following information:

Date of termination of employment:	22 January 2009
Gross weekly pay:	€644.28

Please note that there is a weekly ceiling of €600 on all awards made from the Social Insurance Fund.
