The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

Having heard the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal is satisfied that a genuine redundancy situation existed at the time of his dismissal. Accordingly the Tribunal awards the appellant a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:

Date of Birth: 5 June 1949
Date of commencement of employment: 15 September 2000
Date of termination of employment: 28 November 2008
Gross weekly Pay: € 686.30

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social

Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

Please note that there is a weekly ceiling of €600 on all awards made from the Social insurance Fund.

The Tribunal furthermore awards the appellant the sum of €2745.20 being the equivalent of four weeks pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 to 2005.
