The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

## **Determination:**

Having carefully considered the evidence of both parties in this matter the Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant was employed as a grade D construction operative under the construction industry registered employment agreement working for the respondent's steel erecting, roofing and claddingbusiness. On 16<sup>th</sup> June 2008 the respondent told the appellant that there was no more work for him. The appellant was not told that he was being put on lay-off. In these circumstances the Tribunal issatisfied that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following schedule.

Date of Birth Employment commenced Employment ended Gross weekly pay 25 September 1986 21 May 2006 16 June 2008 €566-00

The Tribunal further awards €1,132-00, being two weeks' pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
