The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of this hearing. Neither he nor a representative on his behalf appeared for this hearing.

The secretariat of the Tribunal received the appellant's T1-A form on 11 December 2008. Among the information on that form was 24 August 2008 as his date of termination with the respondent. Having considered the circumstances of this case the Tribunal accepted there was reasonable cause for this late application.
