## **Determination:**

The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation existed. The appellant commenced employment on 4<sup>th</sup> August 1998. In September 1999 he travelled abroad and recommenced employment with the respondent on 15<sup>th</sup> October 2000.

The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 28<sup>th</sup> November 1976
Date of Commencement: 15<sup>th</sup> October 2000
Date of Termination: 17<sup>th</sup> February 2009

Gross Weekly Wage: €1285.00

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 currently applies to payments from the

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Social Insurance Fund.
