The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Giving sworn testimony, the appellant said that he commenced employment with the respondent in October 2005 (10 October according to the written appeal to the Tribunal) but that the work ceased in December 2008 (12 December on the appeal form). He was paid up to Christmas 2008 and in mid-January 2009 received a P45 which was dated 1 January 2009. He furnished a copy of an excellent reference from the respondent. He sought a redundancy award from the Tribunal.

No evidence was offered by or on behalf of the respondent.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth:	15 February 1980
Date of commencement:	10 October 2005
Date of termination:	01 January 2009
Gross weekly pay:	€894.04

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of $\notin 600.00$ per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
