The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

The appellant accepted that he had received a redundancy lump sum and the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 was withdrawn.

The appellant wrote to the respondent, following a period of lay off, requesting a redundancy payment. Thus he terminated his employment and as a result is not entitled to notice. The claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 fails.

It was common case that the appellant is due a days holiday pay. The appellant is awarded €167.62.
