The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

#### **Determination:**

On the uncontroverted evidence of the appellant, being satisfied that the respondent was on notice of the hearing, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Date of Birth	30 August 1966
Employment commenced	1 March 2006
Employment ended	6 March 2009
Gross weekly pay	€650-00

There was a period of non-reckonable service, by reason of lay-off, from 22 January until 6 March 2009. It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600-00 per week. This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
