## **Determination**

Based on the uncontroverted evidence the Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria

Date of Birth24 January 1974Employment commenced15 January 2005Employment ended9 January 2009Gross weekly pay€632-75

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social

Welfare Acts during the relevant period. It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of  $\[ \in \]$ 600-00 per week. The Tribunal awards  $\[ \in \]$ 1,265-50, being two weeks' pay, under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
